Dear Sansome Families:

In an effort to provide some relief from on-going **indoor recesses**, Sansome students have been walking, running, and dancing through the halls during their morning and afternoon recess breaks while still following cohort protocols! Thank you to Ms. Weekes, Mr. Bell, and Mrs. Starkell for organizing the cohorts for the needed movement breaks.

Sansome has been acknowledging **Treaty #1 Land and Indigenous People** by involving students from Room 33 in sharing their writings around what the Land Acknowledgment means to them personally during our daily announcements. This opportunity provides for genuine student voice and personal connections to the Land Acknowledgements. Thank you to Ms. Paul and students of Room 33 for their work in this area of Reconciliation.

**Covid Update:** All Schools have moved back to the Yellow Response Level. Extracurricular activities, such as basketball, are again permitted. Field Trips will be considered after March 1st. Masks will still be required indoors for staff and students but will **not** be required during PE classes. Medical masks or 3 ply masks for students and staff are recommended and should be snugly fitting. Other cloth masks can again be worn but again should be snugly fitting. Students will remain in cohorts, but cohort sizes may be up to a max. of 75 students. Physical Distancing of 2m. is still a requirement for when students are eating and/or taking mask breaks.

Families are asked to continue to self-monitor for Covid symptoms. We have some additional rapid tests for students on hand at the school. Our weekly absenteeism rate was 0% for the week of Feb. 23rd – 25th.

**Visitors** to the school are still required to wear masks but outdoor mask wearing on SJASD property is now optional although recommended. Physical distancing of 2m is to be maintained when beyond the family cohort.
