We welcome back Mrs. Viera who is returning to Gr. 4.5 from her maternity leave after Spring Break.

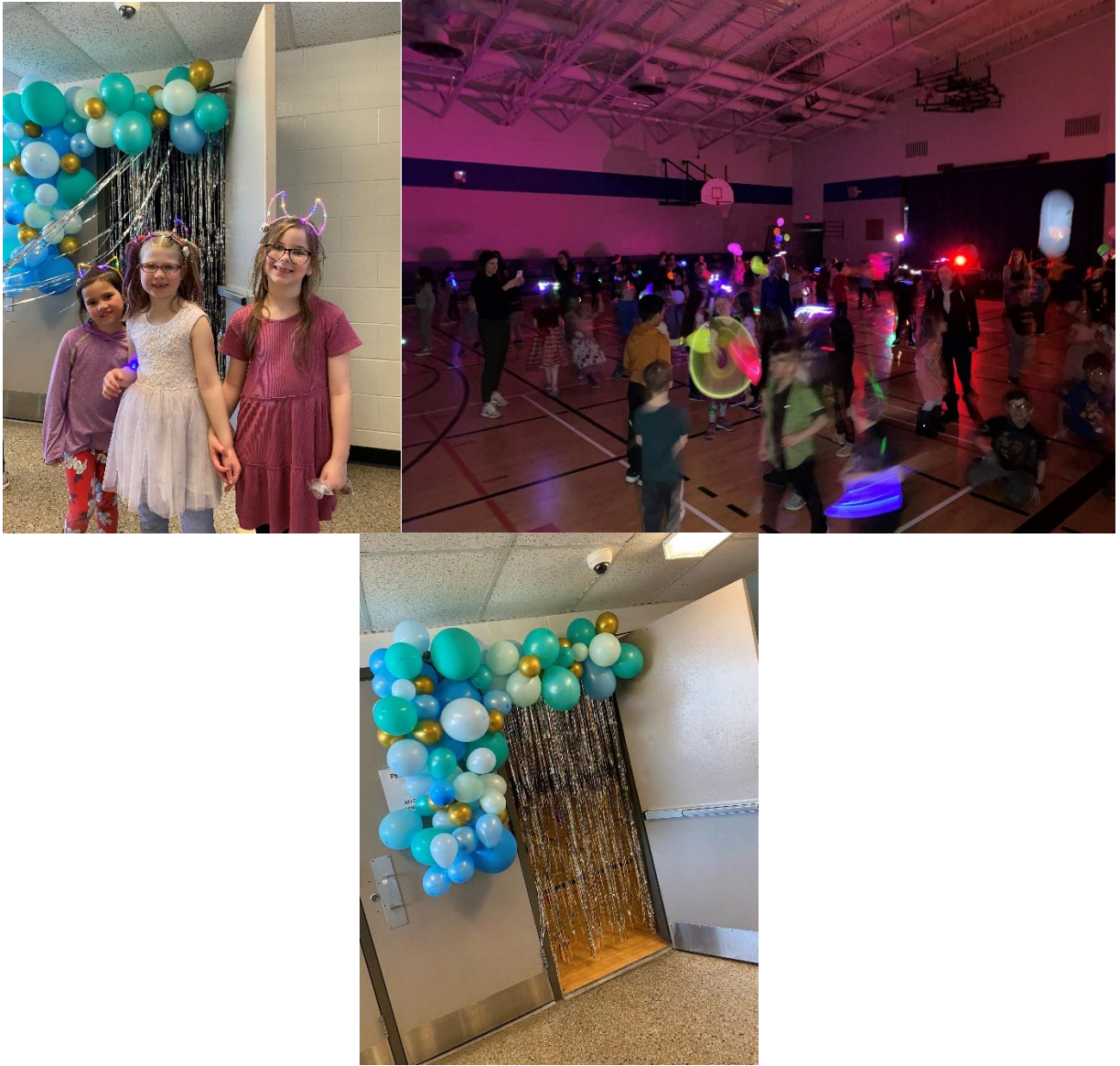
