We have been reminding students and families that we are a “**peanut aware**” school and asking families to send nut free food items to school. In addition to peanuts/nuts, we also have students who are allergic to **fish/shellfish**. We have notified families in the classes where there is such an allergy to refrain from sending fish items such as salmon or tuna. Our Lunch Supervisors have had their virtual URIS training which includes allergic reactions and use of EpiPens. They can reference the URIS alerts posted in the school. We also have allergy alert symbols posted outside of classroom where there is a student with a food allergy. We thank you in advance for your cooperation in keeping everyone safe at school.
