Hello Sansome Families:

Please find attached our **Report to the Community** which reports on our work during the 2021-2022 school year and identifies our goals and priorities for 2022-2023.

We have our Fall session of **Bus Ridership** coming up on October 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>. Each class will be involved in a Bus Safety session provided by our Transportation Department. Sessions will be held on a school bus so that drivers are able to discuss safe loading, unloading, emergency exits as well as safety procedures while riding the bus.
