### **Smudging Blurb:**

Next week, North Star, our Divisional Coordinator of Indigenous Inclusion will be visiting our school to teach us about smudging and indigenous culture.

Smudging has been around for thousands of years, and it allows us honour Indigenous history and culture. Smudging is a mindful practice that involves making a purposeful attempt to slow down and become centered while burning medicines like sage, cedar and sweetgrass. The focus is to connect, reset, or to let go of something negative, and to be grounded.

North Star will be teaching us about smudging and indigenous culture, and there will be opportunities for students and family members to smudge some mornings and at some special events at our school during the school year. Families choose whether their child observes, participates or does not participate in smudging.

#### **CHOIR - Gr. 4/5**

Any students in grades 4 & 5 are welcome to be in the choir! Choir is a singing club that runs every Thursday at lunch recess in the music room. Students who are interested and love to sing are encouraged to come and try it out for the first 2 practices, and after that decide if they want to make the commitment to join the choir.
