Just a reminder of our **entry and dismissal procedures**. Teachers will continue to meet their classes outdoors at their designated entry time and bring the students in one class at a time to avoid congestion. Teachers will bring the class outdoors at their designated dismissal time to meet their parents or to walk home.

Sansome School is open to Parents and the General Public for school business with scheduled appointments. **Medical masks** are required by all adults visiting the building.

We value your involvement in your child's education and hope you will stay connected with us. Teachers and Administrators can be reached by e-mail, telephone, or virtually on Teams.

Lunch Supervisors work from 12:00 PM to 1:00 PM each day that school is in session to supervise students while they eat lunch and then outside on the playground.
