Mrs. Moses and students in class cohorts will be drumming outside on September 29th. To honour Truth and Reconciliation Day, Mrs. Moses and classes will be doing an Indigenous stick game song, written by Cree/Dene educator Sherryl Sewepagaham from Little Red River Cree Nation in Northern Alberta.

Students will be discussing the meaning of Orange Shirt Day, Residential Schools, and Truth and Reconciliation over the course of the week. We will also be participating in a virtual "Orange Shirt Day" Assembly. Teachers will be able to access the link to this assembly between September 27th and October 1st.
