## Sansome School Notes from the Office

Hello Sansome Families:

Welcome to the 2022-2023 School Year!

We are so happy to be opening this school year in the **Green Covid Pandemic Response level!** Information regarding our Division's response to Covid in Green was sent home to all SJASD families earlier this week. If you have any questions or concerns related to Covid please contact us at the school office (204-889-6000). We are mask friendly, and masks will be available for those wishing to wear them during the month of September. Those who wish to continue with masks are asked to bring their own cloth or disposable masks after that.

We will continue to ask families for their cooperation in self-screening for Covid symptoms. We do have some rapid test kits available at the office. Families will be contacted if children are feeling ill at school, and it is recommended they are picked up and recover at home. Hand hygiene and use of hand sanitizer will be encouraged at school.

We are excited to have classroom environments returning to normal and ready for interactive learning activities. We will resume with our regular recess times with all the usual recess equipment. Teachers will be on recess duty as well as before school from 8:45 - 8:55. Teachers will continue to meet their classes outside and bring their groups in at 8:55. Teachers will bring their groups out their respective doors at dismissal time.

We have **new staff** to introduce to our community. We have Chris Mavroudis our Vice Principal; Carol Grant our Reading Recovery Teacher; Shannon Hayward, Educational Assistant; and Saundra Tarr, Educational Assistant. **Transportation:** Please be aware that for the next few days, the buses may/will be running late. There are new drivers, new routes, and lots of students to pick up and drop off. If your bus has not arrived, please be patient and continue to wait at your stop. As a reminder: Sansome bus in the AM is \$17 Sansome bus in the PM is #5

If your child is not going to be on the bus **at the end of the day**, call the office to let us know. If we cannot pick up the phone, please leave us a message.

**Absence Reporting:** A reminder that during the school year, absences are no longer phoned in or emailed to the school/teacher. Please do not email the teacher if your child is going to be absent. If teachers are away, they are not checking their email. Information about the absence reporting system called Safe Arrival is found attached.

Our first Early Dismissal Day is **Tuesday, September 20th**. Students will be dismissed at 3:18 pm to allow for ongoing staff professional development. Early dismissals happen on the first and third Tuesday of each month. Buses run approximately 30 minutes earlier.

The **Milk Store** is open again this year. White and chocolate milk can be purchased for \$1.00 each. Tickets are available in the office. If you have tickets left from last year, they can still be used. Kernels Popcorn will again be sold in the Milk Store for \$2.00 per bag. The flavours available are Butter & Salt, Dill Pickle, Salt & Vinegar, and White Cheddar.

Beginning Monday, September 12th, all Kindergarten, Grade 1 and new students will take part in our annual hearing screening. This process helps identify students who may have a hearing problem that could interfere with their school progress. Students who are identified as 'at risk' during the hearing screening process will be referred to the audiologist at ACCESS Winnipeg West. A letter will be sent home from our school requesting families to contact the Hearing Centre at ACCESS Winnipeg West to arrange an appointment for a complete hearing assessment.
