#### Graduating:



#### Grad Reception

The Grad Reception will take place on Wednesday June 25<sup>th</sup> at the Victoria Inn (South Centennial Room).

Doors open at 5:30 PM and dinner is at 6:00

Grads and their guests must purchase tickets to attend the dinner/reception before the day event.

The reception will include a dinner, speeches, photo opportunities, beverages (non-alchoholic only), and fun.

#### Grad Rehearsal - Monday June 23rd

All Grads are required to attend the one-hour rehearsal on Monday, June 23rd at 10:00 AM in the SJCI gym.

Students will receive their caps and gowns at the rehearsal and will learn the layout and the process for the day.



#### Grad Convocation - Wednesday, June 25th

The Convocation takes place on Wednesday, June 25<sup>th</sup> from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM at the Victoria Inn (the Wellington Ballroom).

Grads must arrive between 9:00-9:15 AM (wearing their caps & gowns) to line up and prepare to cross the stage.

Grads will check in at the Carlton Room and guests can line up at the entrance to the Wellington Room.

Seating for guests first come, first served. There is no cost for Convocation, but seating is limited. Doors open to guests @ 9:30.

<u>Safe Grad:</u> Safe Grad will take place Wednesday, June 25<sup>th</sup> at the Victoria Inn from 10PM until Late (2 AM).

This parent-led, themed event includes dancing, beverages, snacks & activities. <u>School staff will</u> not be in attendance.

Grads must purchase tickets for Safe Grad in June with the option of purchasing for 2 guests.

Alcoholic beverages may only be served and consumed by Grads and guests who are 18+.
