



J Culturally United

J EcoJimmies


Students develop and undertake a variety of projects in our school and recognize events and dates related to local and global sustainability such as Earth Day, Climate marches and World Water Day.

Students learn choreography to perform at the divisional dance showcase in May at MTYP.




J Beading Circle
