### Fire and Evacuation Drill

In collaboration with the Strathmillan Childcare Centre, we will practice a fire and evacuation drill on Wednesday, September 17, at 11 AM.

- First, we will have a conventional fire drill.
- When everyone is accounted for, we will pretend that the building was unsafe to re-enter.
- We will station patrols on Strathmillan, Whytewold, Olive, and Rita, and alleys in between. Our School Patrol Officer from the Winnipeg Police Service will assist.
- We will assemble at Golden Gate Middle School on the front lawn. It's an 8 12-minute walk.
- If it were a real evacuation, we would enter the building, then communicate with parents to arrange for students to be picked up from the site.
- We will re-take attendance, then return to the school.

Please help your child understand that we practice for emergencies so that if they happen, we know how to keep everyone safe.

You may be reading in the news that nearly 200 cases of measles have been reported in children in Manitoba, with some ending up in hospital. Manitoba Public Health has issued a letter about measles and the start of the school year:
