The Big Sun Scholarship gives a \$500 award to a student athlete who has participated in sports, regardless of the exact sport.

The Bison Transport Women to Watch Grant provides a one-time \$500 grant to female-identifying athletes, coaches, officials or volunteers in Manitoba to help cover costs related to their sport development; like training, travel, certification, equipment, competitions or camps.

Curl Manitoba awards multiple scholarships to "active junior curlers" who are entering or enrolled in postsecondary education. They offer up to four \$1,500 scholarships per year.

A \$1,000 scholarship awarded annually to graduating Manitoba high-school volleyball players who have good grades (minimum ~75%) plus strong volleyball, leadership, and community involvement; extra consideration is given if you've played provincially, come from rural Manitoba, or plan to play varsity volleyball at a Canadian college/university.

Ethel Boyce Achievement Award

It is administered by Softball Canada, and is given annually to one male and one female post-secondary student-athlete in Canada who are registered with a provincial/territorial softball association and have demonstrated leadership and skill in softball. Each recipient receives \$1,000.

The Peter Scouras Memorial Scholarship grants \$1,500 to a graduating Manitoba high-school student who is an active member of their school's rugby team, plans to attend post-secondary education, and is committed to continuing rugby.

SNOMAN awards \$1,000 scholarships (one per region) to youth who are active members of a SNOMAN snowmobile club, who have been members for at least two years, and who are graduating high school and planning to enroll full time in postsecondary studies.
