Fee Payments:

We use **School Cash Online** for all student fee payments. The system will open for payments on **Monday, August 25.** There is **no service charge** for using this platform.

Note: Timetable changes will only be processed once student fees are paid and any outstanding library materials have been returned.

Student Fee Schedule:

Graduating Students:

- **\$68.00** – Includes \$35.00 for cap, gown, and convocation photo
- **\$95.00** – Includes the above plus a \$27.00 yearbook

Grades 9-11:

- **\$33.00** – Basic student fee
- **\$60.00** – Includes student fee and \$27.00 yearbook

Note: Yearbooks must be purchased at the time of registration and cannot be ordered later.

Course Specific Fees:

Fees support consumables, guest instructors, and program enhancements. These annual program fees are **non-refundable**.

- **Band:**
 - Instrument Rental: \$120/year
 - Additional Instrument: \$60/year
 - Percussion: \$60/year
- **Dance (Costume Fee):** \$50
- **Musical Theatre:** \$40
- **Sustainable Wilderness:** \$225
- **Culinary Arts:**
 - 20S/G Courses: \$20
 - 30S/40S Courses: \$50
- **Weight Room:** \$50/year

Parking Passes:

Available for **\$40.00**. A valid driver's license is required at the time of application.

School Supplies:

Most students will need:

Some courses may require specific supplies. Teachers will provide these details on the first day of class.

Cell phones:
