Timetable

Student timetables will be available online through **PowerSchool** at the end of August or early September.

Timetable Changes

Timetable changes will only be considered for the following reasons:

- A course required for graduation/program completion
- To fill a spare

Timetable changes will take place in person, by [Collège Sturgeon Heights Collegiate Conference Manager](#) only in room B5. Slots will be available for booking starting on August 19 at 8:00am and will close September 2 at 8:00am.

- Grades 12 – August 31 (9am-12pm)
- Grade 10 – August 31 (1pm-4pm)
- Grades 11 – September 2 (9am-12pm)
- Grade 9 – September 2 (1pm-4pm)
- Drop in – (no appointment necessary) – September 3 (9am-12pm)

To be eligible for a timetable change, students must provide proof of payment for student fees (Receipt # or Confirmation #). Note: Timetable changes will only be processed once student fees are paid and any outstanding library materials have been returned.

Fee Payments:

We use **School Cash Online** for all student fee payments. The system will open for payments on **August 24.**

Student Fee Schedule:

Graduating Students:

- **\$70.00** – Includes \$70.00 for cap, gown, and grad photo

Grades 9-12:

- **\$33.00** – Basic student fee
- **\$35.00** – Includes student fee and \$35.00 yearbook

Course Specific Fees:

These annual program fees are **non-refundable**.

If financial assistance or payment plan is required, please contact the school office.

- **Band:**
 - Instrument Rental: \$120/year
 - Additional Instrument: \$60/year
 - Percussion: \$60/year
- **Dance Fee:**
 - **Dance General (10/20/30/40)** - \$50
 - **Dance Advanced (10/20)** - \$50
 - **Dance Advanced (30/40)** - \$100 (2 semesters)
- **Musical Theatre:** \$50
- **Choir:** \$30
- **Vocal Jazz:** \$30
- **Drama:** \$25
- **Female Fitness:** \$80
- **Sustainable Wilderness:** \$250
- **Weight Room:** \$50/year

Parking Passes:

Available for **\$40.00**. A valid driver's license is required at the time of application. Vehicles without a parking pass will be towed at owners expense.

Food Voucher:

Food vouchers are available for purchase through the school office for **\$10.00** each (over \$15 value).

These vouchers can be redeemed in the school cafeteria and may be used to purchase food and beverages available during regular cafeteria hours.

School Supplies:

Most students will need:

- 1–2 binders
- Loose-leaf paper
- Pens and pencils

Some courses may require specific supplies. Teachers will provide these details on the first day of class.

Cell phones:

Cell phones are not permitted in class. Students must store phones in a designated area or in their lockers. Use is allowed during transitions and lunch only.

Lockers:

Students are responsible for and encouraged to use their lockers to **minimize what they bring to each class**. Food, extra clothing, jackets and supplies should be stored in their locker and accessed when needed.
