10 Words or Less Scholarship

A US/Canada open scholarship for students ages 14–25 who will be attending school in the fall; to apply you submit a 10word (or fewer) answer explaining why you deserve it. Award is \$1,000.

Abbott and Fenner Scholarship Program

For high school juniors/seniors or current post-secondary students; applicants write a 500-1000 word essay about their education and career goals. Winners receive \$1,000.

AES Engineering

Open to high school seniors (not limited to engineering majors) who submit a 500–1000 word essay; awarded for character and leadership, with a prize of \$500.

All Seniors Care Volunteer Scholarship Fund

For high school, college or university students who volunteer regularly (at least 2 hours/week) at a seniors' residence run by All Seniors Care Living Centres Ltd.; depending on your volunteer hours per week (2, 4 or 6 hours) the scholarship award is \$1,000, \$2,000, or \$3,000.

Allied Van Lines Scholarship

A scholarship for Canadian citizens or permanent residents enrolled fulltime in an undergrad program in logistics (or a related field); four students are selected each year, and winners receive \$1,000.

Anthem Essay Contest

Students worldwide in grades 812. Top prizes are typically \$2,000 for first place, plus additional prizes for runners up and finalists. Submit a 600–1,200word essay (in English) on one of several prompts about the novel Anthem by the contest deadline.

B. Davis Scholarship

Awarded annually by Student Award Search Aid to high school juniors/seniors or postsecondary students (no age restriction). \$1,000. Submit an essay (under 1,000 words) on a given leadership related topic.

BGC Scholarship/Bursary Programs

Provides multiple bursaries (valued up to about \$3,000 each) for current or former BGC Winnipeg members enrolled in a postsecondary or vocational training program and demonstrating financial need.

BluEarth Renewables Scholarship Program

Offers up to \$3,000 for fulltime students in Canada in one of three categories: Indigenous students, community leaders, or those enrolled in renewable energy trades programs.

Burger King

Open to graduating high school seniors (or certain Burger King employees/their families) in Canada; scholarships range widely from \$1,000 up to \$60,000 depending on the award.

Cambrian Credit Union: Learning for Life Award

A bursary for Cambrian members in Manitoba who will attend postsecondary school and demonstrate leadership, community service, and academic success; funds go to students across categories such as Arts & Culture, Education, Health & Wellness, and Community Care.

Canadian Nurses Foundation

A national program awarding more than 100 scholarships and bursaries annually to nursing students in Canada (from practical nurse level up to doctoral), with awards ranging roughly from \$750 to \$10,000 depending on program level and criteria.

Colleges and Institutes Canada Paul and Gerri Charette Bursary Program

Provides up to \$5,000 to first or second-year students at colleges or institutes in Canada who demonstrate financial need and face barriers to completing post-secondary education; preference is given to students attending rural, remote, or northern institutions.

The MAC Scholarships support full-time Manitoba students studying in any artistic discipline (e.g. music, visual arts, theatre, dance, media, writing) at certified post-secondary institutions. Award amounts are between \$2,000 and \$3,000.



CPA Manitoba Foundation High School Scholarships

Awards up to thirteen \$1,000 scholarships annually to graduating Grade 12 students who plan to attend a Manitoba university, have an 80%+ average (Grades 10–12), show interest in a business or accounting career, and participate in school or community activities.

A national initiative supporting Filipino-Canadian students going into or currently enrolled in Canadian postsecondary education. The program offers several scholarship streams, each granting minimum \$1,000.

A US/Canadian resident scholarship of \$500 for a fulltime college or university student (by October of the award year) with a GPA of at least 2.5; applicants must submit short essays about spinal health and why they deserve the scholarship.

Offers a \$1,000 postsecondary scholarship to a resident of Headingley, Manitoba who has participated in any Phoenix Recreation programming (sports, community events, volunteer work, etc.) and plans to attend or is enrolled in a postsecondary institution.

For current high-school students from any country who submit a short (1–1.5 minute) original video responding to that year's prompt. First place gets \$1,000.

Jean Murray-Moray Sinclair

A scholarship and apprenticeship, between \$400 and \$1,200 per year, offered by Royal Manitoba Theatre Centre for students pursuing theatre training. Applicants must be residents of Manitoba. They must be enrolled full-time in an accredited theatre school or university theatre program.

Offers a \$1,000 bursary to Canadian youths who are fulltime students and who demonstrate community/school involvement and financial need.

The Poppy Trust Fund bursaries are available to children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren of Veterans (or eligible ex-service persons) who need financial help to attend post-secondary education

MADD Canada

Manitoba Housing: BUILDING Foundations Bursary

National Police Federation

For Canadian post-secondary students studying in the “public safety” field (or related), the NPPFB offers several bursaries: from \$2,500 to \$5,000 annually, plus additional bursaries for children and spouses of active National Police Federation members.



Nellie McClung Trailblazer Scholarships

A scholarship for self-identified female Manitoba residents pursuing careers in STEAM, business, or underrepresented trades. There are five awards for \$1,000.

Orville Erickson Memorial – Canadian Wildlife Federation

This scholarship awards \$500–\$4,000 (to fulltime Canadian postsecondary students studying in a conservation/wildlife-related program.

These awards are for Manitoba residents in Grade 12 who plan to enroll fulltime in a postsecondary program in theatre, music, or technical/production arts (performance, musicianship, or stage-tech). Winners receive a cash award of up to \$750.

Trades, Education, Sports, Performing Arts, Aerospace and other bursaries for Manitoba residents: amounts vary.
