In 1982, an 18 year old named “Porky” was involved in a fatal accident on his way home from a bush party following Grad. His family played an instrumental role in starting SafeGrad to ensure no parent had to suffer a loss like theirs.

Ticket Purchase Details and Requirements

Ticket Price

- Tickets cost \$TBD for grads and guests **CASH ONLY**

Purchase Dates

- Tickets will be on sale from June 1 - 5 during lunch hour in the front lobby. Age verified ID **MUST** be presented with completed forms at time of ticket purchase. Must be a government issued ID that has date of birth

Form Completion

- All forms must be completed at time of ticket purchase (grad form, medical form and guest form (if applicable) Minimum 8 signature areas

Contact Information

- Include the contact name and number for the designated pick up individual they must have had a valid MB drivers license for 5 years



Checklist for Grad & Guest Pickup

▶ Contact

- ▶ Ensure you have provided the designated pickup persons contact information
- ▶ Unknown Calls - be prepared to answer unknown or unrecognized phone calls

▶ Guest Policy

- ▶ If your grad has a guest, they must be picked up at the same time as the grad. If the grad leaves the guest must also leave. If a guest chooses to leave early, the grad can stay.

Venue Arrangements & Check in Process

▶ Grad Dinner

- ▶ Graduation dinner concludes at 10PM sharp - currently working on a slight change
- ▶ Check in between 9:30 - 11:00

▶ Wristbands Provided

- ▶ Everyone will receive wristbands at check in for entry

▶ No In and OUT

- ▶ Participants cannot leave the safegrad room, if they leave they are not allowed re-entry

▶ Contraband Policy IMPORTANT

- ▶ All contraband items will be strictly prohibited and confiscated- the first infraction the grad is sent home, if there is an issue, the bar is shut down and there will be no refunds on tickets already purchased

▶ Sign in/Out Process

- ▶ STUDENTS MUST BE SIGNED IN AND OUT.
- ▶ The pick up person must come inside to sign graduates and guests in and out***

Activities and Entertainment Highlights

- ▶ Complimentary pop and water (mocktails) will be available throughout the evening
- ▶ Alcoholic beverages available until 2:00AM

 - ▶ Drink tickets purchased from cashier
 - ▶ 4 tickets at a time prior to midnight
 - ▶ 2 tickets at a time after midnight
 - ▶ Only ONE drink per person served at a time
 - ▶ Cash/Debit/Credit accepted

- **Volunteer Needs**
