



SCHOLARSHIPS FOR STUDENTS PURSUING A CAREER IN THE TRADES

A1 Auto Transport

Offers three annual awards of \$1,000, \$500, and \$250 to students (full or part-time). Applicants must submit a 1000 word essay on a transport-related topic.

Amelia Earhart Memorial

The Amelia Earhart Memorial Scholarship supports women in aviation by funding flight-training, technical or academic education, and research — offering awards up to US\$20,000 for pilot certificates/ratings or technical courses, up to US\$10,000 toward one year of a college-level aviation/aerospace degree, plus special full scholarships for emergency-maneuver training and grants for broader aviation-related research.

Apprentices registered in a Manitoba-approved apprenticeship program get their technical-training tuition heavily subsidized (on average about \$4,200 per training level).

Aveda Institute

For people applying to start a program at Aveda Winnipeg. To be considered, you must submit a complete application package including the scholarship-qualifier form plus a signed enrolment contract by the deadline.

Electrical Contractors Association of Manitoba

The ECAM Scholarship awards three CA \$1,000 scholarships each year to staff and family members of ECAM-member companies enrolled in post-secondary programs directly tied to the electrical contracting industry (e.g. engineering, construction management, apprenticeship).

Horatio Alger Vocational and Technical Education Scholarship

Aimed at students entering (or enrolled in) vocational or technical certificate or diploma programs (e.g. trades, technical school, community college) instead of a bachelor's degree. The award provides up to \$3,000 to help with tuition or related costs.

A \$1,000 award given annually to one student from Canada studying (full or part-time) at any post-secondary level; applicants must submit a short application and an essay showcasing their digital/creative media interests and work.

Lift Parts Express Scholarship

\$700–\$750 per year for students aged 16–21 who are legal residents of Canada and who are either high-school seniors entering post-secondary, or first- or second-year college/university students. Applicants must submit an online application and write an essay (on that year's topic) as part of the application.

Manitoba Association of Automobiles Club

MAAC awards two annual scholarships of \$500 each to graduating high school students in Manitoba who are planning to pursue further studies in an automotive-related field (either post-secondary school or an apprenticeship/trade program).

Manitoba Hydro

Offers a variety of scholarships, bursaries, and awards to students (high school, college, and university) studying engineering, trades/technology, business, IT, or similar fields. Scholarships are between \$2,000 and \$3,200.

Manitoba Motor Dealers Association

The MMDA offers annual scholarships (typically C\$1,500 each) to Manitoba students (in high school trades or post-secondary studies) pursuing education in fields that could lead to employment at a new car, truck, or heavy-truck dealership (e.g. business, IT, communications, trades).

Manufacturing Trades and Technology Program Scholarship

This scholarship awards \$2,500 to Canadians entering (or already enrolled in) a recognized Manitoba post-secondary program in a manufacturing-related field (e.g. welding, CNC machining, industrial/mechanical engineering, supply-chain, millwright, etc.), provided they demonstrate commitment to pursue a manufacturing career in Manitoba.



Merit Contractors Association of Manitoba Tuition Refund Bursary

This bursary helps employees of Merit member construction companies pay for apprenticeship or occupational skills training by refunding up to \$500 of tuition (per level), provided they complete the training, submit a form with proof of payment and completion, and return to work for at least one month with a Merit employer.

For Manitoba resident secondary or postsecondary students or apprentices preparing for a Red Seal certification in automotive trades (e.g. automotive service, collision repair/ refinishing, heavy duty truck/trailer mechanics). Scholarship is \$1,500.
