Amelia Earhart Memorial

The Amelia Earhart Memorial Scholarship supports women in aviation by funding flight-training, technical or academic education, and research; offering awards up to US\$20,000 for pilot certificates/ratings or technical courses, up to US\$10,000 toward one year of a college-level aviation/aerospace degree, plus special full scholarships for emergency-maneuver training and grants for broader aviation-related research.

Bison Transport Women to Watch

The Bison Transport Women to Watch Grant provides a one-time \$500 grant to female-identifying athletes, coaches, officials or volunteers in Manitoba to help cover costs related to their sport development; like training, travel, certification, equipment, competitions or camps.

Canadian Women in Municipal Government Scholarship

Awarded by a national municipal-government association to young female identifying students who have shown leadership or community involvement at the school or student-council level; scholarship amount varies depending on award cycle.

Congress of Black Women of Manitoba

Offers two \$1,000 scholarships to full-time postsecondary students in Manitoba who self-identify as members of the Black, African, or Caribbean diaspora, demonstrate financial need, strong academics and community involvement/leadership.

Helen Bassett Commemorative Student Award

A \$1,000 award given annually by Native Women's Association of Canada to four Indigenous women, Two Spirit, or gender diverse students (one from each of the four directions: North, East, South, West) who are enrolled in postsecondary studies.

This program helps women who are the primary financial support for themselves and their dependents (children, spouse/partner, siblings/parents, etc.) and who are enrolled into a vocational/skills-training program or an undergraduate degree.

The Manitoba Women's Institute (MWI) scholarship awards two \$1,000 scholarships each year to rural Manitoba students enrolled in recognized academic or vocational courses — supporting those whose studies aim to build skills and capacity for strengthening rural communities, women, families and communities in Manitoba.

Maria Stanson Memorial

The Maria Stanson Memorial Scholarship is a \$1,500 award offered by Manitoba Hydro to a woman who enrolls immediately in Engineering at University of Manitoba after graduating high school — awarded to the applicant with the highest high-school average.

McKinsey Canada Leadership Award

Awards for undergraduate students at Canadian universities who belong to underrepresented groups (e.g. Black, Indigenous, women in STEM, 2SLGBTQIA+) — winners receive \$2,500 and a six-month mentorship with a McKinsey consultant.

Nellie McClung Trailblazer Scholarships

A scholarship for self-identified female Manitoba residents pursuing careers in STEAM, business, or underrepresented trades. There are five awards for \$1,000.

P.E.O. Scholar

The P.E.O. Scholar Award supports women from the U.S. or Canada who are pursuing a doctoral-level degree — awarding a one-time, merit-based grant (up to about US\$25,000) to those with strong academic records, evidence of scholarly achievement, and potential to make significant contributions in their field.

Strike Group – Equity, Diversity and Inclusion

Annual \$2,000 awards for students in post-secondary or trades programs in Western Canada who belong to historically underrepresented communities (e.g. Indigenous, 2SLGBTQIA+, women, new immigrants) and demonstrate academic standing and career/education goals.

Trans Alta Women in Trades Scholarship

For women enrolled full-time in a postsecondary trades or apprenticeship program, this scholarship awards up to around \$2,500–\$3,000 in support.

This scholarship awards \$2,500 to people who identify as women, non-binary, or female-identifying and plan to enroll (or are enrolled) in a program at a Manitoba post-secondary institution that leads to a career in manufacturing.
