St. James-Assiniboia School Division Diploma Planning-French Immersion

The Department of Education requires that students accumulate a minimum of 30 credits to graduate. In order to receive a French Immersion diploma, a minimum of 14 course taught in French are required.

In grades 9 and 10, a minimum of 4 credits must be completed in French and in grades 11 and 12 a minimum of 3.
