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The Early Years (K-5) provides a nurturing environment where children are encouraged to investigate, create and discover. Children develop their competencies in language and literacy skills, thinking and problem-solving skills, social and emotional development, independence, creativity and knowledge in preparation for becoming responsible citizens. Instruction in the following curricula: Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Physical Education/Health and the Arts is focused on meeting the unique needs of Early Years students. Instruction focuses on the integration of subject matter and handson activity-based approaches to learning.

Last Year's School Accomplishments (2021-2022)

The 2021-2022 school year marked our second year as a school community. Our literacy priority was to strengthen students' connections between reading and writing. Our numeracy priority was to deeper our students' understanding of mathematical concepts using critical thinking skills. Our staff and students expanded our wellbeing strategies through deepening our knowledge as well as adjusting our learning spaces to be more inclusive of sensory needs.

Celebrating Our Priorities

Literacy: Students are taking more risks in their writing and are making deeper and more authentic connections with their writing and reading.

Numeracy: Students are increasingly sharing their mathematical thinking with each other which expands their critical thinking and reasoning skills.

Mental Health and Wellbeing: Many classes learned about "sensory cups" and how each of us have different learning needs. Finding strategies that help us regulate our body and mind has been very helpful for our students and staff!
