




Our Schoolyard








How will my child learn French?



THERE ARE 5 AREAS IN LEARNING A LANGUAGE:
LISTENING, UNDERSTANDING, SPEAKING,
READING AND WRITING.

The main focus in Kindergarten is speaking, listening and understanding.

We expect that children will develop language at different rates. They will acquire French while they continue to develop English or other languages at home. They will learn to understand and repeat simple sentence structures and to follow instruction given to them in French. You will be amazed at what they learn in just one year!

In a French Milieu setting, all students in the school are studying in the French Immersion Program and all school activities are conducted in the French language.

Language

The goal of the French Immersion Program is to provide students with the tools they need to be proud, engaged, plurilingual, global citizens. Students at the Kindergarten level are totally immersed in the French language and the language of instruction is French.

At the Early Years level, teachers use a variety of strategies to teach the language such as songs, poems, rhymes, actions, gestures and games. This gives students an opportunity to use their second language skills to develop their fluency and a more diversified vocabulary. Classrooms have many posters and vocabulary word walls to help students with their oral and written skills in French. Many French books are also used as classroom resources.

Culture:

An integral part of the curriculum is to develop a positive attitude towards the French culture. The students easily compare their new found language with their own culture. Early Years schools host an array of activities such as Festival du Voyageur Week, musical performances by French artists, etc. to expose students to the French language and to further develop an awareness of the French culture.

Step 1: Forms

Registration

- 1. Birth Certificate (Original birth certificate is required. Photocopies are not acceptable)
- 2. Manitoba Health card showing child & parent names
- 3. Two Proofs of Residency (eg. MB medical card, valid Manitoba driver's licence, lease agreement, house title or other official documents indicating address of residence.)

** If your child is not born in Canada, you will be required to provide citizenship papers or one of the following documents: Permanent Resident card, Record of Landing, Valid Work Permit/Visa, Valid Study Permit
