6. Principal's Report

Funds/student activities

Start- Up- S. Kent

We discussed our operating funds for the 2020-2021 and the plans for spending of additional funds remaining.

Reflex Math- S. Kent

The cost of this program will be paid for by the parent Council. This was approved in the 2019-2020 school year.

PTE tour- S. Kent
