Math

All teachers will_Increase use of Non-permanent Vertical Learning Spaces (VLS) and/or group interactions to improve critical thinking skills, communication, and understanding at deeper levels

Throughout the year, teachers will Implement journals and reflections to enhance written communication and support analysis of their own work.

Throughout the year, all teachers will continue to incorporate word problems and vocabulary building to enhance content area understanding and language development.

PI

All grade 9 and 10 students will complete at least one oral presentation per year, to enhance communication skills both verbal and non-verbal e.g. oral presentations, visual representations.

Science

At least once per semester, all science teachers will incorporate, "One Pagers" to re-inforce oral and written communication skills. One pagers used for synthesis of ideas and paraphrasing

All Biology teachers will incorporate Case Studies to reinforce communication and critical thinking skills. Case studies used for summarizing, paraphrasing and synthesis. It is an application of concepts.

At least once per semester, all science teachers will use Non-Permanent workspaces to enhance communication and critical thinking skills.

Humanities

At least once per semester, all humanities teachers at all grade levels will require research and inquiry papers to enhance communication, writing for a variety of purposes, and research skills.

For every unit of study that includes a research activity, all teachers will teach internet searching techniques, source evaluation and citation (in text and work cited).

Develop specific activities for examining sources (OPVL) to enhance research skills and further develop as critical global internet citizens.

For all content, all teachers will include critical thinking exercises to enhance student reflection.

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Languages

Every Friday of the month, in grade 9 and 10 French classes, students will complete a "Show and tell" to enhance vocabulary development and communication skills.

Include more "dictées" (spelling tests) in French10F classes to increase vocabulary development improve writing conventions in the target language.

Increase verbal communication in target language through language games, skits, presentations, group interactions and vertical non-permanent learning spaces.

Continue to use technology to develop new vocabulary in the target language.

Arts

Throughout the year, all teachers will continue to incorporate strategies from the "Making Thinking Visible" text to support the development of perspective and understanding at deeper levels.

Throughout the year, teachers will incorporate learning tasks that require students to research online using a variety of primary and secondary sources to enhance art-making, performances, skill building, and research skills.

Throughout the year, all teachers will have students complete reflective journaling to analyze their strengths and weaknesses, enhance written communication, and writing for a variety of purposes.
