

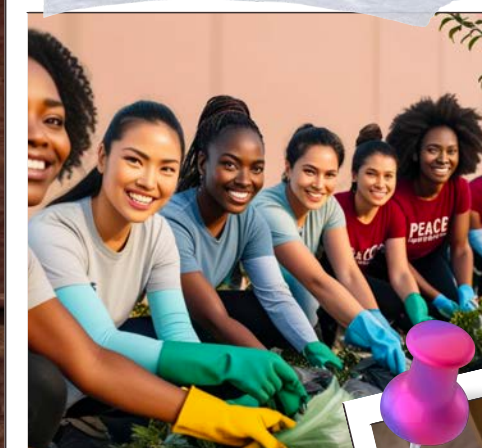

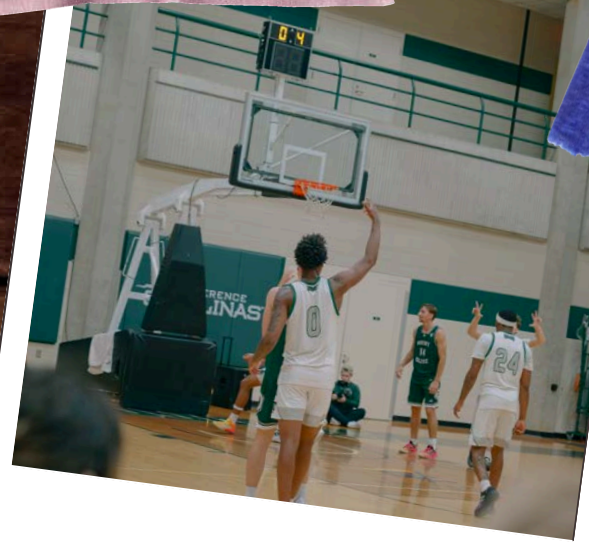
YIP

A student group dedicated to raising awareness and taking action against historically rooted injustices in our community.

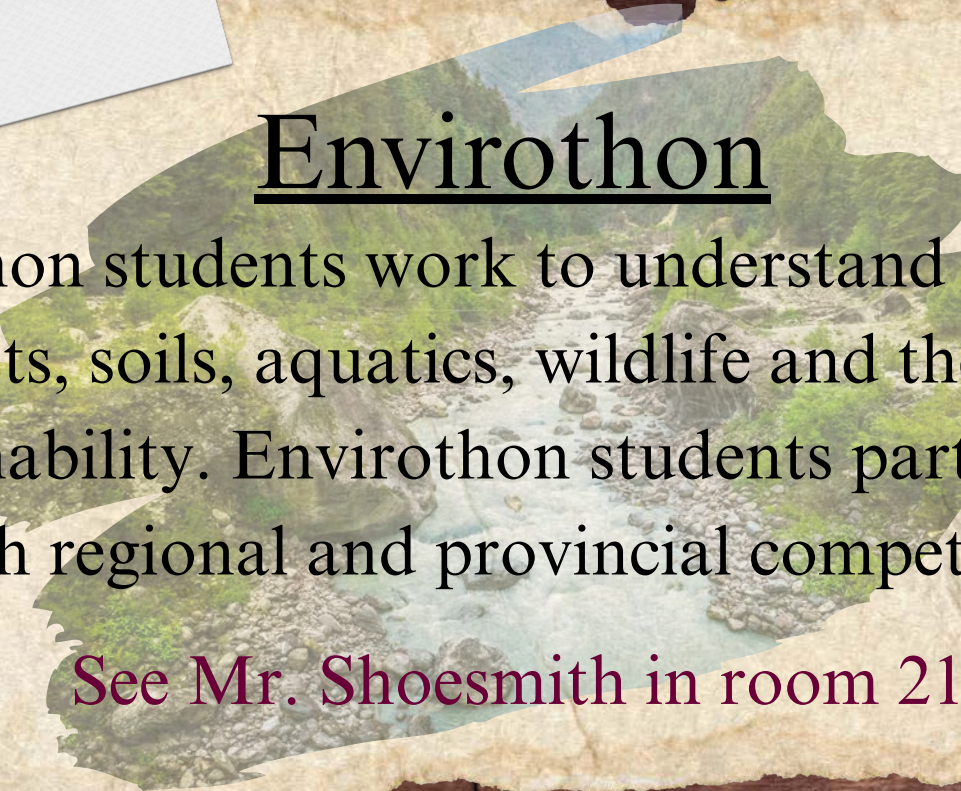

Students who take our Aquatic Science class have the opportunity to get their PADI Open Water Certification!



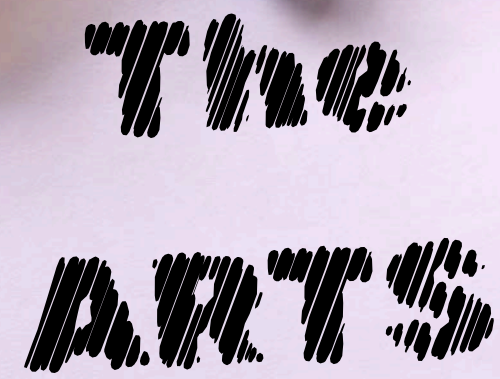
Sustainable Wilderness

Musical Theatre

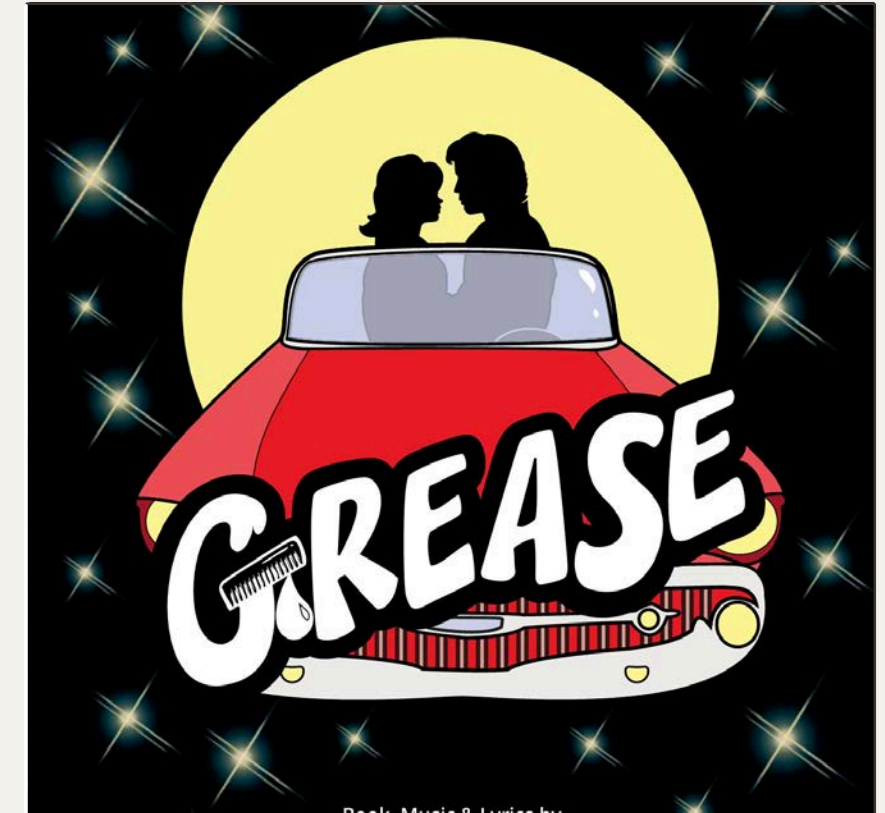
