

F.A.Q Grade 10 Registration

1. What are the compulsory courses in grade 10?
 - a. English 20F
 - b. Math 20SS or Math 20SPA
 - c. Science 20F
 - d. Phys. Ed 20F
 - e. Geography 20F

2. If I already took Geography in grade 9 and passed, do I have to take it again?
 - a. No

3. Can I take a grade 11 course if I've completed the grade 10 prerequisite?
 - a. Yes, but limit this option, there are still 13 electives that must be met between grades 9-12

4. In grade 9 my English class went all year for one credit. Is grade 10 the same?
 - a. NO, EN20F may be in first semester or second but does not go all year.

4. Can I take both Math 20S Essentials and Math 20S Intro to Applied/Pre-Calculus?
 - a. Yes, you can. Both courses offer a different curriculum. It is not a bad idea to select both to ensure you get your grade 10 math credit.

5. Can I take PE21G instead of PE20F?
 - a. No, PE20F is the required PE credit, but you can take both courses in the same year for 2 separate credits as they both have a different course code number.

6. Can a grade 10 student have a spare?
 - a. Yes, we recommend you fill as many courses as possible in grades 9 and 10 to have flexible schedules in grade 11 and 12, BUT, having a spare in grade 10 will not hurt your credits for graduation

7. I'm struggling in one of my classes. What should I do?
 - a. Talk to your teacher. Arrange for extra help with your teacher.
 - b. See assistance from the resource department.
 - c. Arrange for outside support – i.e. Tutoring in school or out of school.
