- ✦ **First day of School: September 8th, 2020**
- ✦ **Start Time: 8:55 a.m. *(students will begin to enter at 8:45 a.m., please do not arrive earlier)**
Lunch Time: 11:45 a.m.-12:55 p.m.
- ✦ **End Time: 3:45 pm*(students will begin to get ready for dismissal at 3:35 pm)**

- ✦ It is very important that your child arrives at school on time so that they can line up and enter the school with their homeroom teacher.
- ✦ *Parents of Grade 1 students are asked to physically distance themselves from the children as they line up at the front of the school with their teacher.*
- ✦ Parents of our Kindergarten, Grade 2, 3, 3 /4 and 4/ 5 students are asked to *kindly wait on the grass during entrance / exits times in order to adhere to the physical distancing protocols and guidelines*, while the students line up on the tarmac in their homeroom classes.
Teacher's will remain with students in their designated dismissal areas until parents pick them up.
- ✦ *Parents who are driving their children to school are encouraged to park at a location further away from the front of the school, at the Assiniboia West Community Centre, or on a nearby side street to avoid traffic congestion on Morgan Crescent. **There is no parking in the staff / daycare parking lot off the back lane.***
- ✦ Adult crossing guards will assist crossing at Ness and Cavalier and at Morgan and Cavalier.
- ✦ Please exit the school yard upon dismissal with your children to maintain social distancing.

Quick Facts

- ✦ Students and staff will remain with their cohorts (classrooms) whenever possible. Recess time and lunch will be staggered.
- ✦ Physical distancing within the cohort is required to the greatest extent possible. Students within a classroom will have desks arranged 1 metre apart.
- ✦ If cohorts are together in a larger space, **4 metres of distance** will be maintained between each cohort. This includes recesses: classrooms will remain separate at recess times until further notice.
- ✦ The play structure is closed during school time until further notice.
- ✦ The milk program is on hold for the month of September.
- ✦ Non-bused students are encouraged to go home for lunch.
- ✦ Both Daycare centers will be hosting their students over the lunch hour. All other students will each lunch in their classrooms.
- ✦ **All eligible school bus passengers in K-5, as well as the driver, are required to wear a non-medical mask. Buses may be running late as we start the new school bus run.**

School Day

- ✦ Core curriculum will be prioritized.
- ✦ The focus will be on responsive learning and strengthening students' literacy and numeracy skills.
- ✦ The focus will be on mental health awareness and positive coping skills.
- ✦ Phys. Ed. will be outdoors as much as possible.

Screening

- ✦ Screen for symptoms every morning. If your child has COVID-19 or flu related symptoms, keep them at home.
- ✦ If symptoms develop while at school, the student will be isolated or kept 2 metres in distance away from others. A space has been designated in the school near the front entrance.
- ✦ The student will be provided with a medical facemask.
- ✦ Parents/caregivers will be contacted immediately to pick up their child.
- ✦ Please make sure your contact information is up to date with the office.

Masks

- ✦ Masks are required at school for grades 3, 3/4, and 4/5 classes when physical distancing is not possible.
- ✦ You will be provided with 2 reusable masks. They should be washed daily and returned for use the next day.
- ✦ Grade 3-5 students who were unable to pick up their masks during the designated times in August, will receive them on September 8th.

School Supplies

- ✦ We have purchased individual school supplies for all students. School supply fees (\$40) can be paid online.
- ✦ Students will require these items labelled with their name:
*A lunch kit, (If staying at school for lunch), *A water bottle (water fountains are closed).
*Indoor runners
*Weather appropriate clothing to support outdoor learning.
- ✦ Each student will have an individual storage bin to store their outdoor clothing and back packs.
