Supplies for grade 6, 7 & 8 students

 - 1 pair of scissors
 - 12 blue or black ink pens

 - 1 pkg. pencil crayons-set of 24 (sharpened)
 - 1 pencil case
 - 1 pencil sharpener (with container attachment to hold the shavings)

Art students must have an art kit. Students who do not have the art kit can purchase one for **\$50.00** (through School Cash Online). The kit will last for 3 years in the program. The kit includes the following.....

- ✓ Set of Drawing Pencils (various gradients)
- ✓ White Vinyl Eraser
- ✓ Large Glue Stick
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Blending Stomp
- ✓ Black Permanent Fine Point Marker
- ✓ 30cm Ruler
- ✓ Set of 24 Pencil Crayons
- ✓ Pencil sharpener (with container attached to hold shavings)

Students who currently have an art kit, make sure you replace anything you may have used up or lost.

Physical Education

For movement, safety, and health (hygiene) reasons it is recommended that students have the following items for each PE/HE class:

- ✓ Gym shoes (non-marking soles)
Note: skate shoes, fashion runners, crocs and flip flops will not be permitted
- ✓ T-shirt
- ✓ Gym shorts, sweatpants or wind pants (preferably without pockets, zippers, snaps)
- ✓ Unscented stick or roll-on deodorant (non-aerosol, no body sprays)
- ✓ Gym bag

For safety reasons, students are expected to remove jewelry during PE classes, Intramurals, and all Gator Athletics programs.

Please label all items in the gym bag and remind your child to take everything home on weekends to be laundered.

Lunch Program

Students who are part of the lunch program will be required to bring a bag lunch.

For all hot food items, students must have a thermos or re-useable container to keep it warm as there will be no microwaves provided in the school to heat up food.

Lockers/Locks

Each student will be assigned a locker and a lock by the homeroom teacher during Opening Day Conferences.

Water Bottles

Students should have their own personal water bottle. The school has water bottle dispensers for student use to refill during the school day.
