

Arts Education at Lincoln

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Students at Lincoln Middle School have the opportunity to participate in a wide variety of Arts programs throughout the school year. To prepare for this involvement, please read the following notices and make note of any needed supplies or programs of interest. Additional supplies may be requested in the fall. Band:

All band students will receive their band book in September. The \$10 fee for the band book, band folio and all sheet music required for the year is now a part of your student fees. Grade 6 band students please make sure you are able to attend our First Lesson Night on **September 18th**. Please make sure you have all the supplies for your instrument. Visual Art:

(Gr.7 and 8 students not enrolled in band)

Visual Art Students will need the following supplies:

- Nylon, zip-up pencil case (big enough to hold supplies listed below)
- Crayola markers - Set of 8
- 1 set of good quality pencil crayons - set of 24
- 1 white, vinyl eraser
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 pair of scissors

The \$10 Art Fee for the Art Kit (which includes a hard cover sketchbook and drawing pencils) is now a part of your student fees.

Concert Dress:

Looking professional at performances is an important part of the band and choral programs at Lincoln. We want to look as good as we sound. All students in Band and the Lincoln Singers are required to have the following at all performances:

- Blue LMS Polo Uniform Shirt
- Black pants (not jeans)
- Black socks
- Black shoes (not runners)

Grade 6 students now pay for their uniform shirt as a part of their student fees (\$15). Returning students who have lost their LMS shirt or grade 7 and 8 students new to Lincoln will need to purchase a new one.

Arts Education Options:

All grade 7 and 8 students at Lincoln participate in three different arts education classes each year. As a part of the registration process you chose your top choices. While students will not know which arts classes they are in until September, please be aware that students in the Visual Art option will need the supplies listed for the Art class. Students in grade 6 will participate in three art education classes: Art, Dance and Drama.
