Mask Pick-Up

- ✦ Mask pick-up for rooms 15, 16 and 5 will be scheduled for the week of August 31-Sept. 4. These families will receive a scheduled pick-up time from the school.

Entry/Dismissal

Your specific entrance/exit:

- ✦ Rooms 15, 16, Kindergarten--North tarmac doors
- ✦ Rooms 3,4,9--Gym Doors on West side of School
- ✦ Rooms 5,8--Front Doors
- ✦ School staff will be present to direct students to their homeroom class line-up locations and designated entrances.
- ✦ Students are expected to keep 2 metres apart as they enter the doors and walk to their classrooms with their teachers.
- ✦ If your child is arriving late, they need to enter through the front doors.
- ✦ Parents are asked to minimize traffic in front of the school by arranging alternative drop-off/meeting spots with their child(ren) at entrance and dismissal times.
- ✦ Upon entry to the school, students will sanitize their hands and go immediately to their classrooms with their teachers.

Quick Facts

- ✦ Students will remain with their homeroom class during the day. Lunch hours and recesses will be staggered. Student recesses and outside lunch breaks will be shared with class(es) that use the same exit/entry location. To start the school year, playzones will be established on the school field for each homeroom.
- ✦ If homeroom cohorts are together in a larger space, **4 metres of distance** will be maintained between each cohort.
- ✦ Phys. Ed. will be outdoors as much as possible.
- ✦ Music will be on pause for the month of September and possibly longer.
- ✦ Students are encouraged to go home for lunch whenever possible.
 - ✦ If a student goes home for lunch, they should not return until the end of the lunch break.
 - ✦ Microwaves are not available for students who stay for lunch.

School Day

- ✦ Currently, the year will run on a standard timetable with the integration of staggered recess and lunch breaks into the school day.
- ✦ Core curriculum will be prioritized for the return to in-class learning.
- ✦ Students will remain in their classrooms and teachers will support students at their designated times.

Screening

- ✦ Screen for symptoms every morning. If your child has COVID-19 or flu related symptoms, keep them at home.
- ✦ If symptoms develop while at school, the student will be isolated or kept 2 metres in distance away from others. A space will be designated in the school.
- ✦ The student will be provided with a medical facemask.
- ✦ Parents/caregivers will be contacted immediately to pick up their child.
- ✦ Please make sure your contact information is up to date with the office.

Masks

- ✦ Students in grades 4-12 are required to wear a mask at school.
- ✦ If you are in a class with grade 4 or 5 students, you will also receive masks to wear.
- ✦ Masks must be on before entering school.
- ✦ Masks should be washed at home daily as they will not be washed at school.

School Supplies

- ✦ Teachers will be providing students with individual school supply packages.
- ✦ Student supply packages will be stored in containers/areas that respect physical distancing.
- ✦ Students are to bring the following on the first day:
 - ✦ A lunch, if necessary.
 - ✦ A water bottle
 - ✦ Please ensure the water bottle is filled at home.
- ✦ Clothing to support time outdoors.
