Principals Report to Parent Council (Henrietta Hoch/Chris Mavroudis):

- Enrolment – Currently at 313 students We had 2 new students start today. We are projecting a min. of 315 students to start the 2023-2024 school year. We currently have 52 in-catchment kindergarten children registered for the fall. Our numbers for next year go into Human Resources and we get our staffing allowances before Spring Break Schools of Choice / Out of Catchment registration has opened and decisions regarding acceptance of those applying are made in June.
- Division Strategic Plan Discussion- The Westwood Community is invited to a conversation regarding the new Strategic Plan at Lincoln Middle School on Wed. April 12th at 6 p.m. The School Board Trustees will be in attendance.
- Tibert, the Voyageur and Douzie were here to perform for all our students this afternoon.
- MTYP will be bringing out their production of “Frozen River” on March 20th p.m. This production is suitable for students in Gr. 2-5. “Frozen River” follows the story of two 11 year olds as they meet in a forest, and that of their descendants who meet in present day Manitoba. A broken promise from the past can be righted when there is finally an openness to learn from those who have protected and honoured the waterways for centuries.
