Kindergarten Registration Information



How do I know if my child is eligible to attend Kindergarten?

All children registering for Kindergarten must be five years old by December 31, 2022 in order to register for Kindergarten starting in September 2022.

How do I know if Strathmillan School is my catchment area school?

All students must register at their catchment area school.

How do I register my child for Kindergarten?

Step 1:

Download a copy of the registration form for Strathmillan School at:

Step 2:

Email your completed registration form to the school office at strathmillan@sjasd.ca on or after January 28, 2022. A confirmation email will be sent to you indicating that your registration form has been received.

or

Call the school office before, on, or after January 28, 2022 at (204)-888-0148. An appointment will be set up for you to drop off the paper copy of your registration form **on January 28th**. You must have an appointment... drop-ins are not permitted. Registration forms can also be returned by siblings of students who currently attend Strathmillan.

Strathmillan School COVID Safe Protocols for Kindergarten Registration

Parents	Must call catchment area school and make an appointment Must SELF SCREEN prior to arrival Must wear a facemask Hand sanitizer available Maintain 2m physical distance Appointment will not exceed 15 mins onsite
Staff	Maintain 2m physical distance Wear facemask

Please note that the following documentation is required for final approval of registration:

- Birth Certificate
- If your child is not born in Canada, you will be required to provide citizenship papers or one of the following documents: Permanent Resident Card, Record of Landing, Valid Work Permit/Visa, Valid Study Permit
- Manitoba Health Card showing child & parent names
- Two Proofs of Residency (eg. MB Medical Card, valid Manitoba Driver's Licence, lease agreement, house title or other official documents indicating address of residence).

Parents may choose to submit copies of this required documentation if they are submitting a hard copy registration form to the office. They will be contacted at a later date to confirm this documentation.

Parents choosing to email their registration form will be contacted at a later date to confirm this documentation.

Parents may indicate a preference for AM or PM Kindergarten. Please note that a preference does not guarantee a particular placement. School administration will contact families to advise of class placements once all registration forms have been reviewed and processed. If space is limited, registrations that are indicating preference of AM or PM Kindergarten will be determined by a lottery process.

How do I express my interest to possibly attend a different school that is not my catchment area school?

All students must first register at their catchment area school.
