CSHC Safe Grad 2024 Information

Dear Parents, Caregivers and Class of 2024!

Graduation is quickly approaching and the **Safe Grad Committee** members, along with all parents and students are trying to ensure Grad Night is a success! After the graduation dinner, the Safe Grad party will be held in the same room at the RBC Convention Centre, at 10:30pm and will end at 3:00 am for pick up.

As part of the Safe Grad Manitoba program, graduates and their guests must provide **2 pieces of ID (one of which must be photo ID)** to the grad committee when safe grad tickets are purchased. Identification can be in the form of a driver's licence, passport, school ID card etc. The photo ID must also be shown upon entry to the Safe Grad room at the RBC Convention Centre **on Thursday, June 27, 2024.** The Security Committee members will check identification and wristbands will be issued to those graduates and their guests who are 18 years of age as of June 27, 2024. Only people with wristbands will be allowed to purchase alcohol.

Cell phones are **not permitted at Safe Grad** and should be sent home with parents or will be kept at the front ticketing desk upon entry.

The Safe Grad event will include a DJ, entertainment stations, prizes and late night food. Graduates and guests will receive "play money" which they can use for entertainment.

Parent volunteers will be on hand to serve food as well as provide security, medical assistance and to operate the entertainment.

Safe Grad provides no transportation! The parent, guardian, or individual designated on the attached form will arrive at the RBC Convention Centre and sign out the graduate and their guest at or before 3:00 AM and then transport them home. If a graduate leaves, their guest must leave at the same time (no exceptions). Graduates and guests may not leave unless they are signed out by the driver designated on their Safe Grad information form. Please provide a phone number where you will be available on June 27, 2024 and the early hours of June 28, 2024, in case your graduate wishes to leave early.

Graduates, please read the rules for the Safe Grad Party and inform your guest and parents. **Parents**, include the names and phone numbers of 1 or 2 designated adults who will pick up your graduate and their guest.

Safe Grad Forms and cash payment (only) will be collected by Safe Grad Parents during the noon hour at the school between

Monday, June 3rd – Friday, June 7th.

The price of Safe Grad tickets will be determined after the completion of our final fundraiser. The estimated cost is \$15-\$25.

CSHC Grad 2024 – General Guidelines

Arriving and Leaving – Safe Grad does not provide transportation!

- Graduates and their Guests are **not** allowed to drive themselves or use transport services after the event. This means that they will need a ride to and from Safe Grad at the RBC Convention Centre.
- Safe Grad will end at 3:00 AM. All the graduates and their guests must be picked up by 3:00 AM.
- \cdot Graduates and their Guests are not permitted to leave the event at any time or for any reason unless they are being signed out by a parent/guardian to go home.
 - Parents/guardians are required to sign out grads and their guests.
 - A guest wishing to leave before the graduate must be signed out by the designated driver on the form. When the graduate leaves, their guest must also leave.
 - As soon as the graduate and their guest are signed out, they are the responsibility of the parent/guardian.
- Guests must be returned to their homes directly to a parent/guardian to ensure safety and minimize liability. The law requires that the designated driver delivers the graduate and guest to their parents/guardians.

It is not sufficient to drop them off in front of their houses.

· Once a graduate and guest leave Safe Grad, they will not be permitted to return.

Admission and Identification

 \cdot Admission to Safe Grad is limited to graduates and their guests. Ticketing/Security will have the list of those who will be allowed entry.

· All parent volunteers will be given badges to identify their role.

\cdot Graduates and guests must provide a photocopy of two pieces of ID, one of which must be photo ID when purchasing tickets.

 \cdot ID must be shown at the door and those graduates and guests who are 18 and over will be given a wristband that will allow them to purchase their own alcohol.

• **Backpacks, large bags, cell phones** and **cameras** are not permitted and IRBC Convention Centre security personnel may search graduates and guests. The Safe Grad Parents Security team will have phones should they be required for contact.

Behaviour

- · Each Graduate is responsible for their own behaviour as well as their guest's behaviour.
- · Destruction of property will not be tolerated and offenders will be sent home.
- · Violent behaviour as an instigator or retaliator will not be tolerated.

No Cell Phones + Cameras

• Graduates and their guests are to hand over their cell phones and cameras to the graduate's parent/guardian or front ticket/security desk prior to entering the Safe Grad venue,

 \cdot Cell phones and cameras are not to be used during Safe Grad and will be held at Security until the graduate and their guest are signed out when they leave.

Food and Non-Alcoholic Bar Service

• Non-alcoholic beverages and food are included in the price of the ticket and will be provided throughout the evening.

Alcohol

- The Liquor Commission Inspectors may visit the Safe Grad for a portion of the evening.
- No alcohol may be brought in from outside Safe Grad. Drugs are not permitted at Safe Grad.
- No one under the age of 18 is allowed to purchase or consume alcohol.
- · If you are of legal drinking age you must show your wrist band before purchasing any alcohol.

 \cdot The RBC Convention Centre will not serve more than 2 drinks per person per visit to the bar. They will not serve double shots.

 \cdot Any graduate or guest found to be excessively inebriated will be sent home. Any graduate or guest who is sick (at any point throughout the evening) will be sent home. Any damage caused because of illness will be at the expense of the graduate.

· Inspectors can shut down the Safe Grad if there is underage drinking

Fines

• Minor in possession of alcohol: \$687.00

- Anyone serving alcohol to a minor: \$2543 -\$20,000 and/or a 6 month jail term.
- Anyone serving alcohol to an intoxicated person: \$2543.00.

Entertainment

 \cdot The Safe Grad Entertainment Committee, in consultation with the Student Grad Committee, will plan entertainment.

The Safe Grad Committee will provide supervision but is not liable.
