# **EXAM GUIDELINES**

- 1) Seating assignments will be posted outside school office.
- 2) Be sure to bring pen(s), pencil(s), eraser, calculator, ruler, white out and whatever else is permitted to help you complete the exam without having to ask for assistance. Only pencils are acceptable for completing bubble sheets.
- 3) Due to the increased ability to communicate and share information between cell phones and other electronic devices, cell phones or other electronic devices cannot be present during exam taking. If one is found in a student's possession while they are in the process of taking an exam, the student will be removed from the exam and will receive a mark of zero. Students are not to have cell phones or other electronic devices in their possession during the examination. Please keep devices in your locker. If students bring them to school, they must give the devices to an examiner prior to starting the exam. Phones or other electronic devices will be returned after the exam is completed.
- 4) Any purses, backpacks, books, notebooks, etc., must be left on the bleachers upon entering the gym. These items may be retrieved upon exiting the gym.
- 5) Morning exam sessions: 8:30 - 11:30 Afternoon exam sessions: 1:00 – 4:00
- 6) Plan to arrive 15 minutes prior to your exam.
- 7) Each exam session will begin with instructions - do not begin exam until instructed to do so.
- 8) You must remain for a minimum of one hour. Then after an announcement, if you have finished, you may completely clear your desk and place all of the various sheets of paper in the appropriate piles or bins at the front of the exam area.
- 9) Maximum time to remain is 3 hrs. Then after an announcement that time to complete an exam is over, proceed to submit your exam at the front of the exam area.
- 10) If you have a question, put up your hand and a teacher will assist you. DO NOT TALK TO OTHER STUDENTS AT ANY TIME.
- 11) If you need to go to the washroom, put up your hand up and a teacher will escort you.
- 12) Water may be tolerated but no beverages or food is permitted.
- 13) Leave the exam area entirely. Do no hang around outside of the exam area.
