

Westwood Collegiate Final Assessment Week, January 29th to February 1st, 2024

The last day of regularly scheduled classes for Grades 10-12 is January 26th. Students in Grades 10-12 will follow the schedule below for assessment week. Students in Grades 10-12 are not required to be at the school January 29 - February 2nd unless they are writing an assessment. Grades 10-12 students not participating in a scheduled Final Assessment on a given day will be provided the opportunity to use this time to ensure successful completion of a course, enhance skills, and/or study where needed. This could include study time/sessions, finalization of course requirements that were not completed during class time, continued practice of skills, and dedicated one-on-one or group time with teachers by appointment. Some courses go all year and are only reaching the half-way point in January.

Grade 9 students will follow their normal schedule with the last day of classes on January 31st. If a grade 9 student is enrolled in a grade 10 class which has an assessment, caregivers should ensure they excuse their child from the regularly scheduled grade 9 class.

Assessments scheduled during the Final Assessment Week will be weighted separate from other assessments within a given course at 10% of the final course grade. This will be communicated in the “exam” column on the report card. Your child’s teachers will communicate the process for these assessments closer to the conclusion of the semester. Student’s assessments will typically take place during a 68-minute block during the scheduled week and will be held in their usual classrooms.
